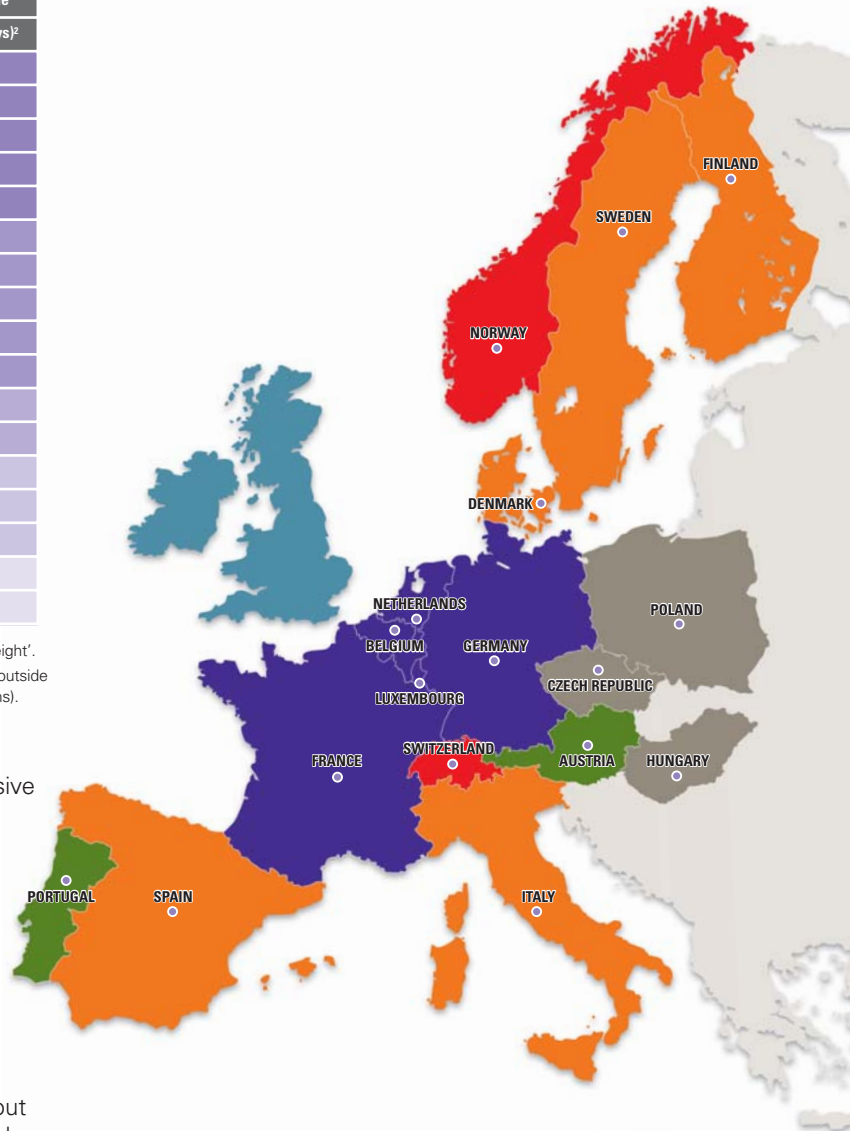
## Customs clearance

## How to prepare your FedEx UK consignment note

A correctly completed consignment note helps to ensure the smooth movement and delivery of your consignment. A FedEx UK consignment note is required for each individual parcel and can be completed online at [uk.fedex.com](http://uk.fedex.com). It is your responsibility to ensure the consignment note is correct and completed in full, this information must be consistent with the information on the export documentation (commercial invoices used for Norway and Switzerland).

### • Sender

Senders name, Senders full address, Senders telephone and fax numbers, Senders reference/account number.

### • Receiver

**\*Receivers name, Receivers full postal address including full postcode/zip code, Receivers telephone number, Contact name.**

### • Detail

Consignment value in £ sterling, A full description of the contents, Number of packages, Chargeable weight, Package dimensions.

\*All items in bold are critical to delivery success.

## Labelling your consignment

Please ensure that you attach one of the small consignment bar codes from the rear of the consignment note, next to the receivers address of the parcel. All items must carry a full address including destination city and postcode/zip code.

## Documentation

For all Non EU parcels (Norway and Switzerland) you must supply all customs documentation (commercial invoices, EUR1 forms etc).

## Duties and Taxes

For Non EU destinations it is the responsibility of the receiver to pay all local duties and taxes.

FedEx UK is not responsible for any local duties and taxes.

## Maximum weight

30 kilos per parcel.

## Maximum / minimum dimensions

120 cms x 60 cms x 50 cms / 25 cms x 10 cms x 5 cms



## Determine the chargeable weight

The amount that you will be charged will be calculated by reference to the greater of either the actual weight or the volumetric weight. The weight is rounded up to the nearest kg. We call this the 'chargeable weight'. An example is shown below.

To calculate the volumetric weight, multiply the length by the width by the height in cm, then divide by 6000.

Length (cm) x Width (cm) Height (cm)	70cm x 50cm x 40cm
